First Aider on site.		
Hazards of road, track and car parking areas	Physical injury	Participants to be made aware of roads and tracks to cross and the risk from road traffic within car parking areas.		
Children getting lost and wandering in to hazardous area	Physical injury	Briefing on activity boundaries and dangers of the river on site and ensure supervision at all times. Due times when Range is in use DO NOT ENTER WOODLAND BEYOND SIGNS. Ensure there is a procedure for recalling groups either by setting a known return time or using a recall signal.		
Course	Physical injury	Inspected thoroughly before use and any defects/dangers with in activity area to be reported.		
Adverse Weather	Physical injury	Brief on dangers of slippery conditions. In the event of thunder and lighting storms a 20 minute rule applies. Anneal dead wooding.
