HAZARD	DANGER/RESULT	HOW DO WE REDUCE THE RISK?/CONTROLS
Slips, trips and falls	Cuts, sprains and breaks	Leaders shall be conversant with the equipment and supervise the activity at all times. This cannot be used without prior permission of the Campsite Warden. Safety briefing including correct use of equipment. First Aider on site at all times.
Falling from height Supervised/Unsupervised climbing on structures. Collapse of structure.	Physical injury	Supervision at all times Leader only allows climbing on structures if considered stable and secure
Tying knots, manoeuvring equipment	Physical injury Trapped toes, fingers	Instruct to keep fingers out of knots and from between spars. Insure plenty of people to lift poles into position.
Carrying poles Lifting/moving structure.	Physical/back injury	Instruction on lifting. Two persons to carry pole one at each end, instruct given to ensure care within group. Structure built near /at site of use.
Adverse Weather	Physical injury	Brief on dangers of wet/slipping conditions and apply as appropriate. In the event of thunder and lightning storms a 20 minute rule applies.
