HAZARD	DANGER/RESULT	HOW DO WE REDUCE THE RISK?/CONTROLS
Slips, trips and falls	Cuts, grazes, sprains and breaks	Leaders shall be conversant with the equipment and supervise the activity at all times. This cannot be used without prior permission of the Campsite Warden. Safety briefing including correct use of equipment and safety helmets to be worn at all times and arms/legs to be covered (gloves optional). First Aider on site.
Confined Spaces	Physical injury,	Supervision at all times. Emergency exits to be unlock and tunnel system to be "Aired" for minimum 10 min inspected and checked by leader. Maximum of 10 participants in the tunnels system at any time. Helmets to be worn at all times. Participants asked to remove loose item from their pockets.
Confined Spaces	Physiological trauma	Participants to be asked before entering if they have a fear of in-closed spaces in if so the emergency doors can be left open and the child should be buddy up and issue with a torch. But under no circumstance should a child have undue pressure put upon them to take part.
Tunnels System	Physical injury	Tunnels System to be inspected thoroughly before use and any defects to be reported and equipment not to be used.
Adverse Weather	Physical injury	Brief on dangers of slippery conditions and trapped water.
