Group Leader in attendance.</li> <li>2. Max group size 10.</li> <li>3. If over crowding of the area occurs refer to EAP overcrowding.</li> <li>4. If the behaviour of the group becomes disorderly refer to EAP disorderly behaviour.</li> </ol>	Yes
Hazards arising from the actions of the Instructor(s)	Participant's instructors and spectators.	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Instructors must pass in-house training and assessment by a GNAS qualified Community Sports Leader or better before being allowed to run a session.</li> <li>2. Record of Instructors qualifications to be kept. If visiting copy of certificate must be seen by camp Staff before range is used.</li> </ol>	Yes

Weather; sessions may become dangerous due to adverse weather conditions	All involved	1. Sessions may have to be cancelled during periods of heavy rain, high winds and mist or reduced visibility.	yes
Injury to people outside the area of the range.	All involved, customers using the area behind the archery range	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Arrow netting to be checked for holes or gaps prior to session.</li> <li>2. Instructor to be aware of group members aiming obviously high of the targets.</li> <li>3. Archery sessions are not permitted at the same time as the full orienteering course is in use. Range Flag must be flying while range in operation.</li> </ol>	yes
